On July 13, 2012, the City of Auburn created the Historic Preservation Commission, which would have principal responsibility for matters of historic preservation within the City of Auburn. On October 8, 2012, the Commission became a Certified Local Government (CLG).

To protect and enhance historic sites and structures in the City of Auburn. To promote a general interest in the history of Auburn.




## GOALS
