Dancers will include students



Business Spotlight: Nemaha Advocates Drug & Alcohol Awareness

Nemaha Advocates Drug & Alcohol Awareness (NADAA) coalition started in August 2005 as a movement of local citizens concerned about the rates of substance abuse, particularly underage drinking in Nemaha County.

The Nemaha County Board of Commissioners made it a priority to establish a substance abuse prevention community coalition to begin addressing priority areas as related to current regional data available at the time. During this current grant period NADAA has partnered with Region V Systems to continue awareness in the community of underage drinking and marijuana usage and its adverse effects.

NADAA seeks to engage with parents of children who are attending daycare centers in the county as well as parents of students who attend both Auburn Public Schools and Johnson Brock Public School. NADAA also encourages attendees of the local Mothers of Preschoolers (MOPS) chapter, 4-H, parents who go to WIC to receive assistance, the local Mennonite community, and the Teammates Mentoring organization to help provide vital input in coalition efforts.

NADAA continuously partners with multiple organizations and agencies with similar missions to implement strategies and activities addressing youth substance use. The Nemaha County Hospital and Nemaha County Commissioners as well as local area businesses have provided ongoing

support for the coalition's efforts in the community.

Jessica Baker is the current NADAA Director. She lives in Peru with her husband and two children. She has an education degree in Family Studies & Child Development. Before taking this position she worked at Head Start and Peru State College.

Mallory Siebold is the current Youth Assistant. Mallory lives outside of Peru with her husband and their daughter and our expecting a son on May 2nd. Mallory is also a graduate of Auburn High School. The Siebolds currently work with youth in their church and through their daughter's activities at Calvert.




