## Highway 136 Construction Continues in Auburn

The Highway 136 construction project in Auburn city limits is moving right along. Hawkins Construction is just completing their second month on the job and the downtown area has been completed, other than some painting. The project has since moved to Phase 2, H to F Street and Phase 3, K St. to Irvin Drive. Phase 2 is nearing completion with both lanes of traffic being poured and now the curbs and sidewalks next

on the list. NDOR estimates that H to F Street should be open to local traffic by mid-June, weather permitting.

Once Phase 2 is complete, this crew should move to Phase 3 and continue to work in this area. Currently, Phase 3 has the south lane removed with dirt work being done. Once the ground has been prepped they will start to pour the lane. Hawkins Construction will probably be using flag men during this

time and be directing traffic through the area to help while they move equipment with pouring. Please expect some stop and go traffic.

Hawkins will also be working on pouring the temporary roadways in Phase 4, which is from Irvin Drive and west.

The next bi-weekly meeting will be at City Hall at the Council Chambers on Tuesday June 10th at 1:00 pm. These are public meetings.

## Did you know...Facts about D-Day. June 6, 1944

10. June 6, 2014 will mark the 70th Anniversary of D-Day.

9. D-Day was the US invasion of German-occupied France at Normandy Beach during World War II.

8. D-Day is the largest seaborne invasion in history.

7. There were 150,000 Allied troops that landed on the beaches of Normandy, with half of them being American soldiers.

6. The invasion was such a heavily guard-

ed secret that even units conducting the invasion did not know the location of their landing sites.

5. Colleville-sur-Mer is the name of the American cemetery at Normandy. It has 9,386 graves that all fast west towards the United States.

4. The "D" in D-Day has no special meaning. It stood for day of invasion, since the date of the invasion was so secretive.

3. There were over 150,000 troops and nearly 3,000 vehicles that stormed the

beach at Normandy. There were also 13,000 paratroopers that parachuted in, along with over 800 planes.

2. D-Day was originally going to happen on June 4, 1944. However, bad weather delayed the operation one day.

1. D-Day was a significant victory because the Allied forces were able to work towards liberating France and it was a big psychological blow to the German army.

To quote Churchill: "Never was so much owed by so many to so few."




