Minutes
March 7, 2014

The Historic Preservation Board met on March 7, 2014, at 11:30, in the Auburn City Hall conference room.

Bob moved to approve the January 24, 2014 minutes as written. Shane seconded. Approved.

Ruben Acosta from Nebraska State Historical Preservation attended the meeting. Ruben is new to the office and will be working with Auburn's CLG. Ruben was helpful in answering questions and giving examples and suggestions. Ruben stated that the National nominations draft from the consultant was well written.

The FY 2014 CLG grant application was reviewed. Bob moves to approve the FY 2014 CLG grant application in the total amount of \$3000.00. This will be \$1800.00 in Federal money and \$1200.00 in a City match. The funds will be used to have brochures designed and printed and some educational outreach workshops. The grant will be submitted to City Council for approval on March 10, 2014. Shane seconds. Approved.

The commission was asked to read pages 22-33 in "The Secretary of Interior's Standard for Rehabilitation and Guidelines for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings". Kris discussed the reading material.

Other Business:

Kim had samples of brochures from other Historic Districts around the country to get ideas for the Auburn Historic District brochures.

Ruben mentioned that the National nomination needs to be in by April 1, 2014. The Nebraska State Historical meeting to approve nominations will be in Hastings, NE May 16th at the public library. Scott, Shane and Kim said they will go and Bob will if he can.
